SHORT PROGRAM

Teachers present a two-hour program for a group that numbers up to 100 students.

<u>Hour One</u>	Shakespeare History: a presentation about Shakespeare, his life, and Elizabethan England. Rapier Demonstration: teachers showcase the basics of stage combat with swords.
<u>Hour Two</u>	Speaking Shakespeare's Language: exploring Elizabethan English and Shakespeare's magic. Iambic Pentameter: how to understand and work with this poetry in motion.

Full Day

Teachers run an in-depth workshop with a group of students numbering 25 or fewer.

<u>Hour One</u>	Introduction: an explanation of what the company does along with a tour of the performance space.
<u>Hour Two</u>	Shakespeare's History: a presentation about Shakespeare, his life, and Elizabethan England.
<u>Hour Three</u>	Speaking Shakespeare's Language: exploring Elizabethan English and Shakespeare's magic.
<u>Hour Four</u>	Basic Acting Skills: projection, articulation, posture, parts of the stage, and so on.
<u>Hour Five</u>	Stage Combat: an introduction to how fighting on stage is choreographed and performed.
